The Underground Bible College was launched on September 14th. Thanks to zoom and other internet video programs, there will be several teachers participating in this new school year from the United States.

# **CHINA**

We have seen a surge of revival in Vietnam this year. The situation in China remains complicated for the team. Some of the China team are still here in the States, waiting for their chance to return. Please pray for them, as they seek for any opportunity to get back to We are praising the Lord for 68 new churches that have China and the ministry there. The other team members who are in China have had to be very flexible, as the situation changes daily.

> Some things have gotten easier for the in-country team, as they are not as closely monitored. But many of our China team members use English teaching as a means for a visa and have run into complications during this time. Because there are so many English teachers who the few teachers who remain in China has raised significantly. Please pray for these team members as they balance these work responsibilities with their ministry schedules.

> The Antioch students at the underground discipleship school are continuing to grow. Though this has been a less than conventional year, we are looking forward to seeing this excellent class graduate at the end of this year and return to their hometowns to pursue further ministry.

> We are still evaluating how we need to change and adjust our ministry strategy in China. Please join us in praying for these decisions.



# **RUSSIA**

This is a letter from one of our National Pastors in Russia taken from the personal update of the Russia Ministry Manager. The baptisms discussed in this letter were able to take place!

### Peace to you, dear friends!

The last three months brought blessings – three more souls met the Lord Jesus and became the children of the great God. Among them, there is our son. On July 12, God willing, we are going to baptize them. On July 11, our church will celebrate its 27th birthday since the first

baptism. We are going to celebrate it with the baptism of its new members. During the isolation period we did not go online, but continued doing regular services as usual. It let us unite around Christ even more. Of course during those three months tithing went down due to salary cuts and your gift is priceless to us, we thank you for it very much.

Please pray for a family retreat (camping) we are going to have this summer. We are going to speak and teach on how important it is to build the family relations on God's principles.

Please, pray for the families that are going to come that their hearts would be open for changes.

In addition, please support us in prayer for construction of our church building: all the project documentation is ready, but we lack necessary finances. We believe that God is the owner of all the finances, and He will give in His time the funds needed for construction.

We pray for you and your team, although we do not know many of you personally, we are one in God's big family.

# **NEED IN NORTH KOREA**

The Lord knows our needs, even before we do. He goes before us, and knows all we will encounter along our way. "Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to shew you by what way ye should go, and in a cloud by day." Deuteronomy 1:33

We are reminded about this by how God reached out to North Korea before the height of the pandemic. OTAN has contacts (we must speak vaguely, as this is sensitive) who are able to get supplies into North Korea. These contacts were able to get rice into North Korea before lock-downs and strict enforcements were put in place.

God knew that things were about to become very difficult world-wide, especially for those in North Korea who are isolated from outside help. We see the physical need for food and basic necessities in all of the countries where we serve as a result of this pandemic. We believe that North Korea's need is greatest.

Our contacts are not yet able to do another run of supplies, but they would like to begin preparations. For now, they watch, and wait for an opportunity. If we provide the finances, they are willing to do the work, regardless of the risks.

- Follow the directions, and once you confirm, you will receive a confirmation text and email with your receipt. Don't forget to save the number to your phone!
- To give again, text the same phone number with the keyword and dollar amount in the message and press send.
