China has opened after three years of COVID lockdowns. It is open now for both in-country and overseas travel. This is extremely important for the continuation of what we do here. With just a visa and a negative test, you can come to China to help! We hope to hold a 'test' English summer camp in 2024, but a lot has to be worked out for that to happen. Please pray for the way to be opened for that.

We are traveling around to visit some of our key workers and past students to determine the health of the church and the workers. Meeting with our friends will be refreshing, and we are excited to make these connections again. We will assess the needs in order to reestablish training that will equip and encourage them for the work for which they have been called.

As many of you have heard, before COVID the church in China was under a lot of persecution: meetings were shutdown, pastors were arrested, and buildings were confiscated. Throughout COVID, the number of people allowed to meet together was greatly limited. This caused many churches to break into small groups or transition to online meetings. Now that things are open, many believers still have not returned to worship services in-person and would rather just be online. Believers should not forsake the assembling together as we see the day approaching (Hebrews 10:25). Reigniting the spark of interest in meeting together for worship, prayer, and teaching is one of the biggest needs in China.
