Financial prosperity in Chinese churches can bring division and misdirected security. Pray that churches would guard their hearts against this.

Pray that young Chinese men and women would respond to the call of the Lord, to salvation and to biblical studies so they can both know Him and serve Him.

The burden of providing for family members can be overwhelming in Chinese society. Pray that the young people who receive training would find a balance between daily needs (family, job, finances) and ministry by trusting in God's provision.

Most Chinese pastors and church leaders hold down several jobs to make ends meet. Pray that church members would understand and fully participate in financially supporting their pastors and leaders
